



NOTES for 2026 AGM

Review of the year since the 2025 AGM.

Planters - All 20 planter boxes were planted, weeded, tidied and watered throughout the year.

A new planter was purchased following a generous donation from a supporter and installed in July 2026 outside Nood. It is hoped that, depending on its condition, some of the timber from the dismantled planter can be reused on some other planters.

Maintenance was also carried out to repair a couple of planters.

Litter picks – Globe organised litter picks during the Reading Festival and some Globe supporters participated in litter picks with Keep Caversham Tidy.

Graffiti - graffiti was tackled in various areas of Caversham. Several incidents of flytipping and flyposting were reported to RBC.

Planning applications - Globe monitored and responded to a number of planning applications on environmental and landscaping issues. Globe supported CADRA in their response to planning applications and appeals, in particular the Planning Appeal relating to 70 new houses proposed on Reading Golf Course in South Oxfordshire.

Publicity - Globe had a stall at the Church Fete in Caversham Court Gardens in July 2026.

Links with other organisations - Globe liaised with other local organisations including CADRA, Keep Caversham Tidy, the North Reading Safer Neighbourhood Forum, Friends of Caversham Court Gardens and Reading Tree Wardens. Globe also contacted RBC officers and ward councillors about several environmental issues.
