

MINUTES & ACTIONS, CAVERSHAM GLOBE MEETING 23 October 2018

ACHIEVEMENTS, UPDATES, PRIORITIES & NEW ITEMS:

Minutes of last monthly meeting held on 25 September 2018 Approved – matters arising were discussed/noted below, with additional items added as discussed in this current meeting.

1. Poor Air Quality

Meeting with RBC Councillors in north Reading to develop a joint approach for remedial action is yet to be arranged. We are awaiting the latest results of the 4 tubes installed in September. **Discuss at next meeting**

- 2. Repair of Planters on Church Street. Project organized for Sunday 4 November to rebuild one of the planters and repair others, as well as planting winter bedding of £105 worth of primulas. The library shrubbery around the centenary Caversham map is also to be cut back and tidied. Bob/Dave to report back at next meeting
- 3. Waitrose area and Archway Rd. Persistent site litter and car parking problems have now been raised by Councillor Barnett-Ward with Waitrose management. Review next meeting
- 4. Finance matters (i) Sources of Grants and Donations to ensure GLOBE group's future and funding of projects. Peter Neville of Elegant Homes (local house builder) presented a cheque donation of £150. Walmsley Estate Agents will donate £100 to be received in November. Review next meeting
- 5. Christchurch Meadows. (i) Logs in the Danall arranged to remove these on 2 November RBC to be asked again about removing tree debris from felled poplar. (ii) Tents by laundry hedge, occupants have removed large section of hedge planted by Globe last winter, it will need replacing. 5 tents in the meadows have been served legal notice to guit. Review next meeting
- **6. Planning application 180869 Hill's meadow car wash**. Landscaping conditions to be enforced 3 years late. **CLOSED**
- 7. Planning Application number 171108 Construction of public transport, pedestrian and cycle bridge and viaduct on land between Thames Valley Business Park and Napier Road Reading. Dave will submit revised GLOBE objections to Wokingham and Reading. Review next meeting
- 8. Planning Application number 181151 Abbotsmead Place 2 x 1 bedroom flats. Plot where trees and undergrowth were removed last year. Revised plans have been submitted. Dave sent in comments. Review next meeting.
- 9. Planning Application number 181471 Rear of 27 to 43 Blenheim Road 5 x 2 storey dwellings on TPO protected woodland, former rear gardens of properties on Kidmore Road. Dave sent GLOBE objections.
- **10.** Litter picking as part of Annual **RESCUE** clean up. Our planned event was rained off and needs to be rescheduled.
- 11. Balmore Walk & nearby street trees work party arranged for 2 November. Review next meeting

- **12.** Environment Agency planned site visit re proposed flood defences GLOBE objected to these proposals (see July minutes). Dave reported that we have been invited to a site walkover and discussion with the Environment Agency; date to be arranged for two people. **Review next meeting**
- **13. Planning Application 181056**. Redevelopment of former Crowne Plaza Hotel car park and construction of new 132-bed hotel. **WITHDRAWN**

- 15. RAYS (Reading Adopt Your Street). 419 people are registered across Reading. More people north of the Thames are needed especially where litter hotspots occur. Ring for information on 0118 937 3534 or email <u>rays@reading.gov.uk</u>.
- **16. Reprinting of GLOBE business cards** These are to be obtained from Vistaprint. **Judith to action**.
- **17. Outline application for 245 dwellings on farmland by Emmer Green**. The Appeal Inquiry against refusal of planning permission decision is expected in November. **Keep in view**.
- **18. AOB item** Caversham Park Pond a resident contacted GLOBE about the state of this pond near Rowallan Close, CPV. This was considered a project more relevant to the work of the TCV or CROW and details had been passed to them. **No further action**.
- 19. 1930s bus shelter, Henley Road opposite The Travellers Rest pub. a resident contacted GLOBE about the state of this structure and the nearby grass verge/pavement, where litter and general poor maintenance are obvious. As a result, a litter pick was done and a priority graffiti report was sent to RBC who removed and repainted. Guttering repair is not within GLOBE's capability. CLOSED
